- C. Council/Commissioner Insurance discussion. A motion to table discussion until The Commissioners meeting on January 9th was made by Councilman Davidson, seconded by Councilman Booth. Motion carried 7-0.
- D. Use of COIT cash Auditor Andel explained that now that the State Board of Accounts had recommended that COIT monies would no longer need to be kept separate from County General, there was no need to keep the money in that fund or keep the fund active. A motion to approve changing the status of the COIT Fund (1121) to dormant and depositing the remaining cash balance of \$85,460.32 into the County General fund was made by Councilman Davidson, seconded by Councilman Chastain. Motion carried 7-0.
- VIII. OLD BUSINESS Auditor Andel requested a decision from the Council regarding the restructuring her office. She wants to use 4 full time employees and 1 part time person instead of using 5 full time employees which will save the County money in the long run. The Council determined that there is no procedure in place to address the desired request. A motion to table the decision to study the request in more depth was made by Councilman Chastain, seconded by Councilman. Motion carried 6-0-1. Auditor Andel was asked to take the request to the Personnel Committee so they can take it up at the February Meeting.

- A. Commissioners' Reports: President Jim Fulwider gave a brief update with regards to the progress of Highway fire recovery.
- B. Auditor Andel reminded the Council that her office was still undergoing the State Board of Accounts 2014 audit.
- C. Recorder Bentley requested an adjustment to the Salary Ordinance to reflect what had been in the Budget Form 1 for 2017. Attorney Taylor advised that an amended Salary Ordinance be produced with those changes.
- D. Sanitarian Amber Reed asked the Council to consider a Council liaison to the Health Board.
