## ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 3

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM FUND

WHEREAS, Montgomery County has established a program to promote the surrender and proper disposal of unused prescription drugs;

AND WHEREAS, the Prescription Drug Program will provide education to develop community awareness of the adverse effects of maintaining unneeded prescription drugs and will facility the proper disposal of such prescription drugs in coordination with law enforcement officials and other stakeholders;

AND WHEREAS, Amber Reed, the Montgomery County Health Officer, has requested that the Board of County Commissioners establish a Montgomery County Prescription Drug Program Fund in order to properly receipt grants, donations, and other sources of revenue for the operation of the program and to pay the expenses associated with the operation of the program;

AND WHEREAS, this Fund will be a non-reverting fund.

AND WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Montgomery County, Indiana, to create this new fund. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section, SECTION 35.28, CHAPTER 35, is hereby added to the

Montgomery County Code, and this section shall read as follows:

"Section 35.28 PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM FUND

(A) *Source of Funds*. There is hereby created a new fund, the Prescription Drug Program Fund (Fund #9169). The source of monies in this fund is grants, donations and other monies for the purpose of assisting the Montgomery County in the administration of the program.

(B) Use of Funds. All monies deposited into the Prescription Drug Program Fund will be used to defray the expenses of the administration of the Prescription Drug Program, including but not limited to the payment of wages and salaries, education and community awareness, office supplies, contractual services, and capital expenses.

(C) *Non-Reverting Fund*. Any money remaining in the Prescription Drug Program Fund at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund, but continues in the Prescription Drug Program Fund. This is a non-reverting fund."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
