## ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 9

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING THE SHERIFF'S FINGERPRINTING FEE FUND

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Sheriff conducts fingerprinting services for which it charges a fee;

AND WHEREAS, the Sheriff has requested that the Board of County

Commissioners establish a Sheriff's Fingerprinting Fee Fund in order to properly

account for fees from the fingerprinting services and the expenditure of such funds;

AND WHEREAS, this Fund will be a non-reverting fund.

AND WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Montgomery County, Indiana, to create this new fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section, SECTION 35.29, CHAPTER 35, is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code, and this section shall read as follows:

"Section 35.29 SHERIFF'S FINGERPRINTING FEE FUND

- (A) *Source of Funds*. There is hereby created a new fund, the Sheriff's Fingerprinting Fee Fund. The source of monies in this fund is fees paid to the Sheriff for fingerprinting services and fees paid to the Sheriff by third party vendors providing fingerprinting services.
- (B) *Use of Funds*. Monies deposited into the Sheriff's Fingerprinting Fee Fund may be used to pay third party vendors providing fingerprinting services, to purchase equipment, to pay salaries and other necessary expenses of providing fingerprinting services, and to pay other expenses of the Sheriff's Department.

(C) *Non-Reverting Fund*. This is a non-reverting fund. Any money remaining in the Sheriff's Fingerprinting Fee Fund at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund, but continues in the Sheriff's Fingerprinting Fee Fund."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
