## **ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 15**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING THE JABG – YSB ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL FUND

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Probation Department has been awarded a grant through the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute and the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant ("JABG"), by which it receives funds or reimbursements for certain qualifying expenditures;

AND WHEREAS, the grant is administered for the County by the Montgomery County Youth Services Bureau;

AND WHEREAS, the Youth Services Bureau has requested the County

Commissioners to establish a new fund in order to properly account for the revenues

and expenditures from the monies associated with the grant;

AND WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Montgomery County, Indiana, to create this new fund, called the JABG – YSB Alternative School Fund;

AND WHEREAS, the fund will be a non-reverting fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section, CHAPTER 35, Section 35.94, is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code, and this section shall read as follows:

## "Section 35.94 JABG – YSB ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL FUND

- (A) *Source of Funds*. There is hereby created a new fund, the JABG YSB Alternative School Fund. The source of monies in this fund is the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant, as reflected in the Grant Agreement entered into between the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute and the Montgomery County Probation Department commencing July 1, 2015, and any amendments or extension to that Agreement.
- (B) *Use of Funds*. Monies deposited into this fund may be used for all legal purposes which are permitted by the grant, which may include but may not be limited to salaries, benefits, supplies, and occupancy costs relating to the alternative school program.
- (C) *Non-Reverting Fund*. This is a non-reverting fund. Any money remaining in the fund at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund, but continues in the fund."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
