## Ordinance 2019-8

## An Ordinance Establishing the 2019 Opioid Response Project Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Health Department has received a \$18,703 grant from the Trustees of Indiana University on behalf of the Indiana Clinical and Transformational Sciences Institute (CTSI), Community Health Partnership (CHeP), and Indiana University Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health (IUSPH) for the CTSI/CHep grant program to assist with the Health Department's opioid recovery project; and

Whereas, the grant funds will be used to provide funds to the expenses of the Health Department's project, including personnel expenses, supplies, travel, and other expenses; and

Whereas, in order to receive the grant, it is necessary to establish a fund for the grant; and

Whereas, Director Amber Reed of the Health Department has requested that the Board of Commissioners establish the 2019 Opioid Recovery Response Project Grant Fund so that the grant funds can be deposited and from which the expenses of the program can be paid in a manner and form consistent with the terms of the grant; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2019 Opioid Recovery Response Project Grant Fund, should be established in order to facilitate the receipt and administration of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.122, is hereby added to Chapter 35 of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the 2019 Opioid Recovery Response Grant Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

## "§ 35.122 2019 OPIOID RECOVERY RESPONSE PROJECT GRANT FUND

- (A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2019 Opioid Recovery Response Project Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received by the Montgomery County Health Department from the Trustees of Indiana University on behalf of the Indiana Clinical and Transformational Sciences Institute (CTSI), Community Health Partnership (CHeP), and the Indiana University Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health (IUSPH), pursuant to a grant request.
- (B) Use of Funds. All money in the Fund will be used to pay for expenses relating to the Health Department's Opioid Recovery Response Project, including payment of expenses for personnel, supplies, travel and other expenses, consistent with the Department's grant.
- (C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
