Ordinance 2019-7

An Ordinance Establishing the 2019 JCAP Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department has received a \$43,000 grant from the Indiana Drug Enforcement Association (IDEA) to provide services to men and women in jail who struggle with addiction issues; and

Whereas, the grant funds will be used to provide funds to the Sheriff's Department in the treatment of addiction, including payment for services, materials and resources from Valley Oakes and the Indiana Addiction Issues Coalition and resources and supplies for the life skills classes; and

Whereas, in order to receive the grant, it is necessary to establish a fund for the grant; and

Whereas, Sheriff Ryan Needham has requested that the Board of Commissioners establish the 2019 JCAP Grant Fund so that the grant funds can be deposited and from which the expenses of the program can be paid in a manner and form consistent with the terms of the grant; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2019 JCAP Grant Fund, should be established in order to facilitate the receipt and administration of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.121, is hereby added to Chapter 35 of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the 2019 JCAP Grant Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

"§ 35.121 2019 JCAP GRANT FUND

- (A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2019 JCAP Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received by the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department from the Indiana Drug Enforcement Association (IDEA) pursuant to a grant request.
- (B) *Use of Funds.* All money in the Fund will be used to pay for expenses relating to the treatment of men and women in jail who struggle with addiction issues and who meet the criteria of the program, and these grant funds will be used to pay for services, materials and supplies consistent with the Department's grant.
- (C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
