Ordinance 2020-2

An Ordinance Establishing the FFY 2019 Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Emergency Management Agency has received a \$2,497.88 grant from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security for expenses related to the NEMA Conference, a Federal Fiscal Year 2019 Emergency Performance Grant; and

Whereas, in order to receive the grant, it is necessary to establish a fund for the grant; and

Whereas, Emergency Management Director Shari Harrington, has requested that the Board of Commissioners establish the FFY 2019 Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) Grant Fund so that the grant funds can be deposited and from which the expenses of the program can be paid in a manner and form consistent with the terms of the grant; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the FFY 2019 Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) Grant Fund, should be established in order to facilitate the receipt and administration of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.134, is hereby added to Chapter 35 of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the FFY 2019

Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) Grant Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

“§ 35.134 FFY 2019 Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) GRANT FUND


- (A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the FFY 2019 Emergency Management Performance (NEMA) Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of grant monies received by the Montgomery County Emergency Management Agency from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security.
- (B) *Use of Funds.* All money in the Fund will be used to pay for expenses associated with the NEMA conference, consistent with the Agency’s grant agreement with the Indiana Department of Homeland Security.
- (C) *Non-Reverting Fund.* This is a Non-Reverting Fund.”


It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
