**Ordinance 2023 – 23**

**An Ordinance Creating the  
FY 2024 DOC Drug Court Grant Fund**

**Whereas**, the Montgomery County Probation Department has been awarded by the Indiana Department of Correction the FY2024 Community Corrections & Justice Reinvestment Grant in the amount of \$80,441 for funding the Drug Court Program; and

**Whereas**, the use of funds from the grant award may be used by the Montgomery County Probation Department consistent with the terms and conditions of the grant agreement; and

**Whereas**, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, Creating FY2024 DOC Drug Court Grant, should be created in order to receive the funds from the Indiana Department of Corrections and to provide a mechanism for appropriation and accounting for the funds used; and

**Therefore, it is ordained** that a new section, Section 35.\_\_\_\_ of the Montgomery County Code, is hereby added to the County Code and that this new section shall read as follows:

**"§ 35.\_\_\_\_ FY24 DOC Drug Court Grant Fund**


(A) ***Source of Funds.*** The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the FY2024 Drug Court Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received by the Indiana Department of Corrections the


FY24 Drug Court Grant Award. This grant runs from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.


- (B) **Use of Funds.** All monies of the FY2024 DOC Drug Court Grant Fund will be used consistent with the grant award of \$80,441 to provide funding specifically \$68,790 salary for Probation Officer Eric Cutts; \$9,251 for FICA/PERF; \$600 cell phone reimbursement and \$1,800 conferences with the grant agreement entered into by and between the Montgomery County Probation Department and CY2024 Community Corrections & Justice Reinvestment Grants.
- (C) **Non-Reverting Fund.** This fund shall be non-reverting and remain in effect until modified or rescinded by the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners.
- (D) **Severability.** If any provision of this ordinance is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this ordinance not otherwise invalidated will remain in full force and effect.
- (E) **Non-Reverting Fund.** This is a Non-Reverting Fund."


