

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL TRUST INDENTURE

THIS FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL TRUST INDENTURE, executed and dated as of the first day of December, 2022 ("First Supplemental Indenture"), supplementing the Trust Indenture dated as of April 1, 2022 ("Original Indenture"), by and between MONTGOMERY COUNTY, INDIANA ("Issuer" and "County"), a political subdivision duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana, and REGIONS BANK, an Alabama state-chartered banking corporation, with a corporate trust office in the City of Clayton, Missouri ("Trustee") (the Original Indenture as supplemented by this First Supplemental Trust Indenture and as further supplemented and amended from time to time is referred to as the "Indenture").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Original Indenture the Issuer authorized, sold and delivered \$7,735,000 of its Taxable Economic Development Revenue Bonds of 2022 (IAW/CSX Project), dated April 19, 2022 to finance the costs of constructing or causing the construction of utility and rail infrastructure improvements, together with all necessary appurtenances, related improvements and equipment;

WHEREAS, the Original Indenture is being supplemented and amended pursuant to Sections 9.1(a) of the Original Indenture; and

The Issuer has agreed and covenanted, and does hereby agree and covenant, with the Trustee and with the respective owners, from time to time, of the bonds or any part thereof, as follows, that is to say:

(End of preamble)

SECTION 1. Section 4.3(b) of the Original Indenture is amended and restated as follows:

"(b) Moneys on deposit in the Construction Fund shall be paid out from time to time by the Trustee upon the order of the Issuer to pay costs of issuance of the Bonds, and to pay, or as reimbursement to the Contracting Parties or the Issuer for payment made, for the Costs of Construction, upon receipt by the Trustee of an invoice showing the Costs of Construction and to whom payment is owed and a Written Request in the form set forth on Exhibit B, signed by the Authorized Representative of the Company and approved by the Issuer:"

SECTION 2. Exhibit B of the Original Indenture is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Executive Summary

Scope of Services

The Montgomery County LEPC is requesting services to develop and conduct a tabletop exercise to be completed in 2024 (we are using for budget purposes up to 30 players). The purpose of the exercise program will be to test the response portions of Montgomery

County's LEPC/HAZMAT plans in response to a reportable quantity of an extremely hazardous substance event. The objectives and scenario are to be developed by the Exercise Committee members through the exercise design process.

Project Management

Upon completion of the meetings, we will complete the relevant documentation based on HSEEP guidance, including the situation manual (SITMAN), based on the information compiled. The completed document will be posted to BaseCamp for review and distribution.

Exercise Planning

Resilient Strategies will facilitate and complete the following sequence of Meetings and/or tasks for the Montgomery County LEPC Exercise Committee:

• Exercise Evaluation Guides (EEG)

Resilient Strategies will develop from the HSEEP guides, based upon the Core Capabilities List, the specific task objectives to be evaluated during the exercise based upon exercise goals.

Upon selection of the core capabilities and specific task objectives, concise guides will be developed, and the completed guides will be posted to BaseCamp for distribution.

Major Events and SITMAN

The goals for this milestone are to develop the major events, expected actions, and messages to take place during the TTX. These events are then broken down into modules that will be completed over the course of the TTX, along with identifying specific tasks to be completed and then communicated to the group by the participants. Any reference materials will be determined, including local information and agent fact sheets.

Based upon the guidance from the Exercise Committee, Resilient Strategies will complete on its own the above milestones and will document the Situation Manual (SITMAN) based upon the agreed upon information for use in the facilitation of the exercise. The document will be posted to BaseCamp for distribution.

Final Planning Meeting

The goals for the final planning Meeting are to resolve remaining planning issues, including the safety plan, participant orientation, security and control measures, logistics, and all documentation.

Exercise Conduct

Resilient Strategies will utilize our Indiana based emergency response team to provide the appropriate facilitation, control, and evaluation for the exercise. During the conduct of the exercise, these resources will be identified and will provide guidance ensuring exercise goals are met. Planned resource allowances include:

Table Top Exercise - One Lead Facilitator and One Controller/Evaluator

Upon completion of each of the exercise, we will aid in facilitating the "Hot Wash" to capture the participants' comments and feedback on the exercise response. The notes from each of the briefings will be posted to BaseCamp.

Exercise Summary

Resilient Strategies will facilitate the following Meeting and prepare the following report for the Montgomery County LEPC Exercise Committee:

Resilient Strategies will next document a draft After Action Report that includes a summary of issues identified, supporting analysis from the hot wash and after action Meeting, and final recommendations. We will then facilitate the After Action Meeting to review the identified areas that were successfully completed and develop and assign those that need improvement into a corrective action plan. The areas for improvement will be prioritized based on impact on the community and ability to be resolved and then assigned to the responsible agency and officer. Resilient Strategies will leverage its Indiana based emergency response evaluation team to provide invaluable third-party input and guidance during the review that will help differentiate the exercise as a

success training endeavor.

The reviewed AAR will be delivered directly to the Exercise Committee, and also posted to BaseCamp for the LEPC to complete and implement.

Investment and Payment Schedule

This engagement will be delivered on a fixed bid basis for the exercise to include consulting time and expenses for the tabletop exercise. The investment for this project, based on the deliverables outlined above and the project estimates is \$5,495 for the exercise. If it is deemed during the engagement that the scope changes and the resource requirements to complete this project will vary significantly from this estimate, Resilient Strategies will notify the Montgomery County LEPC immediately.

Dear Jake,

This is a follow-up letter to our recent discussion concerning the closure of the location listed above. Traffic restrictions are expected to begin 4/26/2023 with an estimated completion date of mid-May 2024. The total closure time for this project will be approximately 14 days.

The Official Detour, in accordance with IC 8-23-21 and shown on the attached map, will utilize U.S. 136 to S.R. 32 to I-74 to S.R. 75 to U.S. 136. The Unofficial Detour, as shown on the attached map, is proposed to be US-136 to CR 1050 East to CR 600 South to US-136. The Unofficial Detour will be in effect during the same time period as the Official Detour.

INDOT will set up and maintain the necessary signage and traffic control for the Official Detour route or arrange with others to furnish the necessary items. The Unofficial Detour route will not be signed as a detour. Your County Commissioners will be responsible for any necessary weight restriction signage on the Unofficial Detour.

INDOT agrees to reimburse your County for costs related to damage repair on the listed Unofficial Detour. Reimbursable work must be pre-approved by INDOT prior to the completion of any work. All expenses must be documented to be considered for reimbursement. Once the District has agreed to the documented expenses, INDOT and the County must execute an agreement concerning reimbursement for the repairs. This will not occur until after the INDOT Official Detour is eliminated.





2nd Reading Ordinance 2024-11 Adopting a Policy for Disposal of Lost or Abandoned Personal Property by Sheriff

Ordinance 2024-11

Adopting a Policy for Disposal of Lost or Abandoned Personal Property by Sheriff

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office often comes into possession of lost or abandoned personal property that is unclaimed; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has requested the Board of Commissioners to adopt a policy for the disposal of lost or abandoned personal property if the rightful owner cannot be located and/or the property remains unclaimed;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests that in such circumstances the Sheriff be authorized to release the property to its owner or, if the owner cannot be located, then the Sheriff be authorized to dispose of the property as surplus property.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that the Board of Commissioners now adopts the following policy to be added to the County Code as Section 36.43 as follows:

"36.43. DISPOSAL OF LOST OR ABANDONED PERSONAL PROPERTY HELD BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

(A) RETENTION PERIOD AND RETURN OF PROPERTY

- (1) Lost, abandoned and unclaimed personal property (hereinafter referred to as "property") shall be held and stored by the Sheriff, for a period of 60 days during which time the Sheriff and the Sheriff's Office shall make a reasonable and diligent attempt to:
 - (a) Ascertain the rightful ownership and cause the return of property being held; provided that, the rightful owner(s) are otherwise lawfully eligible to receive and possess such property according to the laws of the United States and the State; and
 - (b) Determine whether such property is of any evidentiary value in any current or foreseeable prosecution or appellate proceeding and if so, then the Sheriff will maintain custody of the property until the property is no longer needed as evidence or until such time as a court orders the release and/or disposition of the property.

(B) DISPOSAL OF PROPERTY AS SURPLUS

- (1) If the Sheriff cannot ascertain the owner of the property on or before the expiration of the 60-day retention period of this section, the property is declared surplus and the Sheriff shall dispose of all such property as follows:
 - (a) The disposal of such property shall be in accordance with I.C. 5-22-22-1 et seq., as amended from time to time.
 - (b) All monies collected pursuant to such disposal, if any, shall first be used to defray the necessary costs of administering this section, with such surplus as there may be, along with a detailed accounting of such proceeds received for each item sold and each cost paid, being delivered to the Auditor of the county.
- (2) Notwithstanding any provision of this section, the owner(s) of such property may present a claim to the Sheriff's Office for the return of same and, if first fully satisfied of the validity of said claim, the Sheriff shall return the claimed property to such rightful owner(s) if such owner(s) shall be lawfully eligible to receive and possess such property according to the laws of the United States and the state; provided that, such claims shall be made before disposal as herein provided.
- (3) The Auditor of the county shall cause all net proceeds of each sale to be deposited into the Couty General Fund.

(C) APPLICABILITY.

This ordinance shall govern only lost, abandoned and unclaimed personal property coming into possession of the Sheriff's Office and all items of property seized by the Sheriff's Office as a result of an arrest, search warrant, or warrantless search shall be governed by I.C. 35-33-5-5.

(D)SEVERABILITY.

If any clause, phrase, provision or section of this section, or application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or render void any other clause, phrase, provision, section or application of this section which can be given effect without the invalid part of application thereof. It is the intention of the Board of Commissioners, in the adoption of this section to adopt each clause, phrase, provision of this section are declared to be severable."

RESOLUTION DETERMINING NEED FOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") has investigated the need for funding the renovation of the County courthouse ("Project") located in Montgomery County, Indiana ("County");

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the County and its residents to proceed with the Project;

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-1-10 ("Act") a leasing entity is required to own the real estate ("Property") on which the Project will be renovated to be leased to the County and the County is required to have the value of the Property determined by two independent appraisers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, supporting taxpayer petitions signed by at least 50 property taxpayers in the County is required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

- Section 1. The Board hereby determines, after investigation, that a need exists for the renovation of the Project. The Board hereby further determines that in order to move forward with the Project, it intends to approve funding needed for the Project and/or support other governmental bodies or departments of the County in funding the Project.
- Section 2. The Board has received the independent appraisal of Sedgwick Valuation Services Division for the Property and hereby accepts and ratifies such appraisal.
- Section 3. The Board hereby ratifies and approves the appointment of an additional independent appraiser in order to determine the fair market value of the Property.
- Section 4. The Board hereby authorizes the circulation of the proposed petition of taxpayers requesting the lease of the Project.
- Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
