Ordinance 2018-21

An Ordinance Establishing the Health Department 2018/2019 Preparedness Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Health Department has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$15,475.00 from the Indiana State Department of Health for the 2018/2019 Preparedness Grant; and

Whereas, these funds will be used to pay for compensation and benefits for a preparedness coordinator and other expenses associated with the administration of the grant; and

Whereas, the terms and conditions of this grant require Montgomery

County to establish a grant fund for the funds to be deposited; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the Health Department 2018/2019 Preparedness Grant Fund, should be established in order to facilitate the administration of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.117, is hereby added to Chapter 35 of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the Health Department 2018/2019 Preparedness Grant Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

"§ 35.117 HEALTH DEPARTMENT 2018/2019 PREPAREDNESS GRANT FUND

(A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the Health Department 2018/2019 Preparedness Grant Fund.

The funds shall consist of monies received by the Montgomery County Health Department from the Indiana State Department of Health Division

of Emergency Preparedness grant program.

(B) Use of Funds. All money of the Health Department 2018/2019

Preparedness Grant Fund will be used consistent with the grant agreement and in conformance with Federal Code 42 USC 247d-3b and will be used to

provide compensation and benefits for a preparedness coordinator and

other expenses of the administration of the grant.

(C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon

adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery

County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this

ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
