Ordinance 2019-1

An Ordinance Establishing the 2019 Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Superior Court 1 has received a \$38,500 grant from the Indiana Supreme Court for the Montgomery County Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program; and

Whereas, in order to receive the grant, it is necessary to establish a fund for the grant; and

Whereas, Judge Heather Barajas of the Montgomery County Superior Court 1 has requested that the Board of Commissioners establish the 2019 Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program Grant Fund so that the grant funds can be deposited and from which the expenses of the program can be paid in a manner and form consistent with the terms of the grant;

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2019 Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program Grant Fund, should be established in order to facilitate the receipt and administration of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.119, is hereby added to Chapter 35 of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances

establishing the 2019 Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program Grant Fund,
and this section shall read as follows:

“§ 35.119 2019 VOLUNTEER ADULT GUARDIANSHIP PROGRAM GRANT FUND


- (A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2019 Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received by the Montgomery Superior Court 1 from the Indiana Supreme Court pursuant to a grant request for fund to support the program.
- (B) *Use of Funds.* All money in the Fund will be used to pay for expenses of the Volunteer Adult Guardianship Program as provided for by the terms and conditions of the grant from the Indiana Supreme Court.
- (C) *Non-Reverting Fund.* This is a Non-Reverting Fund.”

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon
adoption.


It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery




