Hoosier GNCC 5/1 to 5/2 - Request to Close Portions of CR200S & CR200W - Lori Shaver Iron Man Raceway is hosting a race on May 1 and May 2 and they are requesting authorization to close a portion of CR 200 South and CR 200 West during the event.

Highway Department:

Grader Lease

New leases for 4 new graders. The lease cost has increased by \$75,000 per year. Distributor Lease

Lease of a new distributor for "chip and sealing" roads. Staff worked with the State's HELP program for purchasing equipment and US Bank has provided the most competitive lease proposal with an interest rate of 2.05%. It will be a seven year lease with a total annual payment of \$34,258.42.

Tree Removal Quote

3 large trees need to be removed prior to the installation of two new culverts. Indiana Tree Service has submitted a proposal with a total cost of \$8,000. Four other tree removal companies were contacted but we did not receive proposal from them. Operational Report

The 2020 Operational Report provides data on the operations of the Highway Department for 2020. It is required to be submitted to LTAP on an annual basis.

Public Safety Telecommunicator Week Proclamation

Vacates a portion of Clay Street in Shannondale at the request of an adjacent property owner. The public hearing will be held at the April 26 Board of Commissioners meeting.

Montgomery County Board of Commissioners Ordinance 2021-15

AN ORDINANCE CREATING 2021 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND

Whereas, Congress passed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 on March 11, 2021, to provide additional relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses; and

Whereas, Montgomery County will receive or has received Local Fiscal Recovery Funds of \$______, for local governments for relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on local government; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act Fund, should be created in order to receive the monies from the grant and to provide a mechanism for the use and accounting of these monies; and

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.153 of the Montgomery County Code, is hereby added to the County Code and that this new section shall read as follows:

"§ 35.153 2021 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND

(A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, as provided for in the Act, to provide additional relief to address the continued impact

of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses.

(B) *Use of Funds.* All money in the Fund will be used consistent with the County's ARP Plan and federal law for the following purposes:

(1) To respond to the public health emergency ("PHE") concerning Covid-19 or negate its negative impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits; or

(2) Aid to impact industries such as travel, tourism, and hospitality;

(3) To respond to worker's performing essential work during the PHE by providing premium pay to eligible workers of the County that are performing such essential work, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who perform essential work.

(4) To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure.

(5) Provide services to the extent of the reduction in revenue.

(6) The funds may not be used to make pension payments; or offset revenue losses resulting from any tax cut, tax delay, or tax rebate enacted after March 3, 2021.

(7) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code

of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in

full force and effect.
