- B. Auditor Jennifer Andel shared she has completed the Annual Financial Reports for the County, as well as the Redevelopment Authority. She is currently working on the Abstract of Taxes and reported that taxpayers should soon be able to view their property tax bills online.
- C. Sheriff Ryan Needham announced the DLZ study on the Jail was submitted and extended an offer to have DLZ present the findings to the Council.

  - A. Marc Bonwell, Building Administrator, provided an update from the Plan Commission and the new county annex project.
  - B. Amber Reed, Health Department, reported the clinics are running well. She is currently working with the Community Paramedicine Program to get an in-home vaccination option available to our homebound citizens.

  - F. Shari Harrington, EMA Director, provided a review of the last snow event. She reminded everyone of CodeRed, the new alert system available to everyone. She also has one open position in her department.
  - G. Lori Dossett, Executive Assistant to the Commissioners, provided an update on the new Solid Waste District.
