V. New Business:

- A. Resolution 2022-5 Adopting an Updated Investment Policy
 - 1. County Attorney Dan Taylor presented Resolution 2022-5, which will replace the current policy expiring in May 2022.
 - 2. Councilman Booth made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilman Hunt. Motion carried 5-
- B. DLZ Presentation on Courthouse Study
 - 1. DLZ provided the highlights of their study on the Courthouse updates needed, including planning goals, schedule of work and budget. Their intent is to maintain the historical integrity of the Courthouse. They suggest starting with exterior maintenance to ensure building is watertight

before starting interior projects.

- C. Fiscal Plan Updates Peters Franklin LTD
 - 1. Jeff Peters presented the Fiscal Plan Updates. He spoke about EMS and Jail needs and options to cover those costs. He commended the County for being able to reestablish cash balances.
- D. ERPS Committee Recommendations
 - 1. Tom Klein presented on behalf of the ERPS Committee.
 - 2. The Health Department requested increases on four positions. These increases were already approved by the Health Board, so it was simply out of courtesy. Funding is already available. EPRS made a favorable recommendation.
 - 3. The Probation Department wanted to create a new position, Grant Administrator. The position wasn't funded. ERPS made a non-favorable recommendation, stating they would reevaluate during the 2023 Budget process.
 - a. Councilman Bohlander made a motion to accept the ERPS recommendation, seconded by Councilman Booth. Motion carried 5-0.
 - 4. The Public Defender asked for a Chief Deputy position to be created with a starting salary of \$90,000 and his Deputy PD's starting salary increase to \$70,000. He had much support from the Judges present, Barajas and Petrie. ERPS made a position recommendation.
 - a. Councilman Hunt made a motion to accept the ERPS recommendation, seconded by Councilman Smith. Motion carried 5-0.
- VI. OLD BUSINESS: None.

- A. Tom Klein, County Administrator
 - 1. Tom requested the Council and Commissioners meet in a joint work session on the financial plan.
 - 2. He recognized E911 as it is National Public Safety Telecommunicator's Week.
 - 3. He congratulated Sarah Hines on 20 years of service to the County.
 - 4. He spoke on upcoming Bicentennial events.
 - 5. He announced that County Engineer, Jim Peck, would be leaving the County and thanked him for his service.
- B. Treasurer Heather Laffoon announced the tax bills have been sent to print and should be mailing in the next few weeks.

A. Chief Probation Officer, Andria Geigle, asked the Council to be aware that there will be mandatory increases to the salaries in the 2023 Budget for her department.
