The Montgomery County Government Center Project consisted of purchasing and remodeling the vacant Williamsburg Nursing Home to establish offices and meeting spaces for County Government. The project started in August of 2020 and the County offices started to move to the new Government Center on March 14, 2022. The cost to purchase and remodel the facility was \$5,544,000. Financing for the project was through a bond by the Montgomery County Building Corporation.

The following offices are at the Montgomery County Government Center: Assessor, Auditor, Building/Zoning, Commissioners, Engineering, Health, Mapping, Maintenance, Recorder, Surveyor, Treasurer and Veteran Services.

The Art Gallery at the Montgomery County Government Center consists of over 100 pieces of art donated by local residents. Over 90% of the artists are from Montgomery County with the remaining art pieces purchased from an art show at the Athens Art Gallery.
