Highway Director Lough requested approval to issue a Notice to Bidders for three bridge deck replacements. Two of these bridges are on 950 S between 47 and 625 W. The other bridge is located on 700 N between 950 E & 900 E. Sealed bids due July 22, 2022 at 2:30 pm open them July 25th. Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve the Notice to Bidders for three Bridge Deck Replacements. Seconded by Commissioner Frey. Motion passed 2-0 votes in favor.

DLZ Professional Services Letter Agreement - County Courthouse

Agreement to design Montgomery County Courthouse Exterior improvements on all four facades of the Courthouse, roof repairs, war memorial cleaning, and miscellaneous landscaping. The project will be with a single unified contractor. Fee - Hourly, not to exceed \$132,000. Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve the DLZ Professional Services Letter as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Frey. Motion passed 2-0 votes in favor.

MOU - Montgomery County/City of Crawfordsville - Landfill Cap Stabilization Project

Project: Move dirt stored at Random House to landfill to fill in

low areas as identified in the plans developed by Butler Fairman & Seifert.

Reestablish a ditch to convey water to a retention area.

The City of Crawfordsville and the County will share the project costs is a 50/50.

Parties agree the right to reject any and all bids.

Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve the MOU between Montgomery County Commissioners and the City of Crawfordsville. Seconded by Commissioner Frey. Motion passed 2-0 votes in favor.

Assessor Sherri Bentley requested approval of a contract with Schneider which will add document access report module(s) on County's Beacon site an also link to pre-rendered PDF files generated by County for each document. Annual hosting fee of \$672.

Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve the Professional Services Agreement with Schneider. Seconded by Commissioner Frey. Motion passed 2-0 votes in favor.

2nd Reading: Ordinance 2022-21: Amending Road Stop Schedule - Current yield sign on Old Oak Hill Road should be changed to a stop sign. The ordinance will amend Chapter 70 of the Code Book. *Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve Ordinance 2022-21. Seconded by Commissioner Frey. Motion passed 2-0 votes in favor.*

Introduction: Ordinance 2022-22: Creating 2022-2023 Drug Free Montgomery County Coalition Grant Fund

Montgomery County Probation Department received six Mini-Grants (total of \$15,330) by the Drug Free Montgomery County Coalition/Local Coordinating Council. Substance Abuse Assessments: \$4,050; Juvenile Cognitive Behavioral Programs: \$2,600; Veteran Treatment Court Incentives: \$1,000; Drug Court Incentives: \$3,000; Juvenile and Young Adult Drug Screening: \$1,680; Emergency/transitional housing: \$3,000.

RESOLUTIONS

Resolution 2022-5: A Declaration of Surplus - As a result of the relocation of the 1st floor of the Courthouse; South Boulevard & 308 West Market Street to the Government Center there were left behind several miscellaneous pieces of furniture which have found to be of no use and no value. Also, declard surplus miscellaneous pieces of office furniture in the County Barn located at the end of Whitlock Avenue. In order to dispose of the property, it is being requested to be declared as surplus. Commissioner Fulwider moved to approve Resolution 2022-5. Seconded by Commissioner Guard. Motion passed 3-0 votes in favor.

OTHER BUSINESS

County Administrator Tom Klein announced that Highway Director Jake Lough has completed 12 core courses offered through LTP to receive his Road Building Certificate and now he is working to obtain his Master Road Builder Certification.
