Ordinance 2023-5

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE 2023 VETERAN COURT PROBLEM SOLVING GRANT FUND

Whereas, the Montgomery County Veterans Court has been approved by the Indiana Supreme Court, Office of Judicial Administration, Indiana Office of Court Services to receive a grant in the amount of \$7,500 for incentives; training; chemical testing; emergency housing; and transportation, as detailed in the grant agreement. This grant runs from April 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023; and

Whereas, the use of funds from the grant award may be used by the Montgomery County Veterans Court consistent with the terms and conditions of the grant award and grant agreement; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2023 Veteran Court Problem-Solving Grant Fund, should be created in order to receive the funds from the Indiana Supreme Court and to provide a mechanism for appropriation and accounting for the funds used.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.___ of the Montgomery County Code, is hereby added to the County Code and that this new section shall read as follows:

"§ 35.____ 2023 PSC Vet Court Grant Fund

- (A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2023 Veteran Court PSC Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received by the Veterans Court from the Indiana Supreme Court for the 2023 PSC Vet Court grant award. This grant runs from April 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.
- (B) Use of Funds. All money of the 2023 PSC Veteran Court Grant Fund will be used consistent with the grant award to provide (1,200) for incentives; (\$2,800) for chemical testing; (\$500) for emergency housing; and (\$500) for transportation, in a form and manner consistent with the award.
- (C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
