

ORDINANCE 2015-7

**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT ON
A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 150 SOUTH**

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners are authorized to impose various regulations on the roadways within the county, including limitations on the weight of vehicles travelling upon certain roadways;

AND WHEREAS, the County Highway Director has recommended that a vehicular weight limit of 5 tons be placed on County Road 150 South between State Road 47 and State Road 231 in order to prevent the deterioration of the road caused by trucks carrying loads in excess of the road design and condition, and the Commissioners find that such a restriction should be imposed.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners that no trucks weighing more than 5 tons shall travel upon County Road 150 South between State Road 47 and State Road 231, with local deliveries excepted, and the County Highway Director shall cause signs to be placed at appropriate locations to inform the public of this restriction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to monetary fines in the following amounts:

First violation:	\$100;
Second violation within 12 months:	\$250;
Each subsequent violation within a 12 month period:	\$500.
