Update on Locution Project & Priority Dispatch

CCC Director Sherri Hill stated that they are working out the kinks and grid mapping. They hope to get Crawfordsville done before the end of the summer. Rural agencies will stay generic. Priortiy dispatch had a kickoff meeting. Certifications will start with medical and fire and then law in the fall. Weekly meetings are happening. Priority Dispatch hopes to go live by late summer. There will be a stakeholders meeting in July about Priority Dispatch.

Financial Report. Seconded by County Councilman David Hunt. Motion passed 4-0 votes in favor.


VI. Adjournment
